Doctorate of Pharmacy Program Coming soon!*

The new doctorate in Pharmacy program (Pharm.D.) will accept its first class in fall 2010. The Pre-pharmacy program, which began in fall 2009, prepares students for admission into the Pharm.D. program. A B.S./Pharm.D. option is also available for students who qualify. It offers three years of Pre-pharmacy and three years in the Pharm.D. program, saving a year of study and getting you into the workforce sooner!

Weekend Program for Adult Learners

The new Saint Joseph College Weekend Program for Adult Learners offers undergraduate professional degrees for working women and men who are returning to college. The Weekend Program is priced comparably to other public and private adult learning programs at \$450 per credit. Classes are held on weeknights, weekends, and online. The program offers:

Financial Aid Process

Apply for financial aid at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Saint Joseph College's school code is 001409. If you have already completed the FAFSA and would now like the information sent to Saint Joseph College, visit the above Web site or call 1-800-4FEDAID and provide our school code.

Scholarships

- Merit awards. Ranging from \$2,500 - \$7,000 for full-time transfer students. Students with a 3.0 cumulative GPA and higher can qualify for \$5,000 - \$7,000
- The Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship. \$8,000 for full-time students who are members of this two-year college honor society; renewable for up to four years of undergraduate study.
- Full-time transfer students in the Weekend Program for Adult Learners may also qualify for merit awards valued at up to \$3,500 per year.
- The TEACH Grant Program provides assistance for students with a GPA of 3.25 or higher who agree to teach for at least four

years within eight years of completing (or otherwise ceasing to be enrolled in) the program that awarded the TEACH Grant. Students may receive \$4,000 per year, up to a maximum of \$16,000 for undergraduate, and \$8,000 for graduate study. The grant is reduced for part-time students. Transfer This Spring!

- Apply online at www.sjc.edu, and we will waive the \$50 application fee
- Transfer students must submit both high school and post-secondary records; adult learners must submit post-secondary and in some cases, high school transcripts.

The following supplemental materials, although not required, are highly recommended:

- A personal statement about your academic, college, or personal goals
- A resume of professional experience, honors, and/or extra-curricular activities
- One or two teacher/counselor recommendations

Free Tuition for Veterans SJC and the Yellow Ribbon Program
