HEALTH REQUIREMENTS SUMMARY

MMR/MEASLES, MUMPS, RUBELLA: all students except those born before 1957 must submit vaccine records or blood test results.

VARICELLA (CHICKENPOX): all students born except those born in the United States before 1980 must submit a record of two vaccines or proof of illness/immunity.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION: all full-time undergraduates, including commuters and transfer students; Adult Learner program students exempt. Update(s) required nursing students every two years.

MENINGITIS: one vaccine required for residential students.

HEALTH INSURANCE VERIFICATION: full-time undergraduate students registered for 12 or more credits are required to maintain health insurance coverage including students in the Adult Learner program. Please submit a copy of the insurance card with health records.

TUBERCULOSIS TESTING: Health care and international students please include ppd test results with your physical examination. Annual ppd testing required during clinical sequence of nursing program.

HEPATITIS B: Health care students should complete the three vaccine series before entering clinical rotations.

HEALTH FORM GUIDELINES

Deadlines: Fall-August 15th; Spring-January 3rd; Summer-May 15th

Women's College (undergraduate):

Please submit the Saint Joseph College "Physical Examination/Student Medical History" form. Transfer students may submit a comparable document from prior college if dated no more than two years previous.

Adult Learner (undergraduate weekend program):

Please submit the Saint Joseph College "Proof of Immunization" form. Records from other institutions or sources may be attached. Must perform annual health insurance waiver if registered for 12 or more credits.

Pharmacy students

Health form deadlines may vary. Please refer to School of Pharmacy documents.

All full-time students

Students covered by another insurance plan must perform an annual waiver in order to receive credit for the student insurance fee. Instructions on performing the online waiver form are distributed during new student orientations. The fall semester waiver period is 6/15 to 9/15 and 12/1 to 2/1 in the spring semester.

Student Athletes (intercollegiate):

Please submit the Athletics Department "Pre-participation Physical Exam" form.
