**Health form deadlines:** Fall semester-August 15<sup>th</sup>; Spring semester-January 3<sup>rd</sup>.  
*International and Pharmacy students should submit forms by July 15<sup>th</sup>.*

**Insurance waiver processing:** Online waivers accepted from 6.15 to 9.15 (Fall) and 12.1 to 2.1 (Spring)

*All full-time undergraduate students will be charged and enrolled in a college affiliated health insurance plan unless an insurance waiver is submitted annually. Waiver should be completed in the fall unless the student is not attending in the fall, then it should be done prior to the spring semester. If covered by another health insurance plan, in order to be credited for the fee an online waiver must be completed during the waiver period each year. Weekend Program students are included in this requirement. Follow the link from mySJC during the processing periods to perform the online waiver.*

**Required Vaccines** (see health forms for further detail)

MMR: 2 vaccines or equivalent for all students born in or after 1957.

Varicella: 2 vaccines or equivalent for all students born in or after 1980 and/or those born outside of the U.S.

Meningitis: 1 Menactra or equivalent quadrivalent meningitis vaccine required for all residents including international and visiting students.
