In his new role, Mr. Sherman provides vision, strategic leadership, planning and coordination for recruitment, admissions and enrollment programs. He oversees the Offices of Admissions and Student Financial Services.

Mr. Sherman most recently served as Vice President for Enrollment Management at North Carolina Wesleyan College (NCWC) where he was responsible for admissions, financial aid, and athletics. He led and organized the effort to internationalize NCWC's main campus; created a partnership with regional community colleges to facilitate transfers; and restructured financial aid processes to maximize recruitment and retention.

Before joining NCWC, Mr. Sherman was at Averett University (Danville, Va.) for over 10 years as Dean of Enrollment Management and then Vice President for Enrollment Management. He also served as Director of Undergraduate Admission at Marywood University (Scranton, Penn.).

Mr. Sherman holds a B.S. in Psychology/Communications from Shepherd University (Shepherdstown, W.Va.) and an M.S. in Student Personnel/Counseling from Shippensburg University (Shippensburg, Penn.).
