Dedicated to people of color and the American experience, Spectrum in Motion builds choreography that reflects the life experiences of company members. Artistic Director Olivia Ilano-Davis shares universal human emotions inspired by the dance and music of world cultures.

Spectrum in Motion was founded in 1982 in the Pioneer Valley of Western Massachusetts with the premise that dance should help us to tell and share the stories of our lives. Spectrum in Motion is the resident dance education and performance ensemble at Charter Oak Cultural Center, located at 21 Charter Oak Avenue in Hartford. Growing from being a group of high-energy student dancers with many talents and much potential, Spectrum in Motion has evolved to become a group of serious dancers who have matured into a company. Most of the company's members are Hartford natives who have also applied their own experiences to teaching and mentoring youngsters from the city. Some members of the company desire to continue to dance professionally; others are preparing for diverse careers but all understand that within this experience, the art form is a learning tool. Spectrum in Motion embraces the simple notion that dance is for everyone – we should all be dancing!
